

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

➤ *How much does it cost to enter the Berwick Show?*

Tickets can be purchased at the gate on the Saturday or Sunday.

Adults - \$20

Family (includes 2x adult & 2x paying age children) - \$40

Concession - \$15

Children 10-16 - \$10

10 years and under – FREE

➤ *Are companion cards accepted?* YES

The Show Society wishes to be as inclusive as possible to all patrons attending our event. Therefore, it is our policy that any disability or concession card holder pay the relevant entry fee, and any one carer (with sufficient i.d. shown on entry) will be entitled to free complimentary entry

➤ *Do you have EFTPOS at the gates?* YES

➤ *What time does the Show open?*

The Berwick Show opens to the public at 9am both Saturday and Sunday.

➤ *What time do the gates close?*

All gates will close at 9pm except for Gate 4 which will remain open to just prior to the fireworks at 9.30pm

➤ *Is there an ATM machine available?*

There will be an ATM machine available near the Akoonah Park Centre.

➤ *What time are the fireworks?*

The Fireworks display is on Saturday at 9.30 pm.

➤ *Do you have disabled parking?* YES

To access disabled parking enter Gate 1 off Princes Hwy.

➤ **Are dogs allowed at the show?** 

As much as we love our dogs, on Show Days dogs belonging to the general public are unable to enter our event unless they are Service dogs wearing their coats. Dogs belonging to exhibitors are allowed into the Showgrounds except in signed restricted areas ie. Cattle section, Food Court, and must always be on a leash.

➤ **What activities are free?**

- **Kidding Around Area** – full of fun activities all free to participate eg. Making fruit rockets, facepainting, plaster painting, sandpit, pony rides, animal nursery, drawing to name a few. Free tea and coffee for adults within the Kidding Around area. .
Saturday 10am - 5pm Sunday 9 – 3pm You will find this area on the grassed area East of the Main Arena. Look out for the directional signs.
- **Animal Nursery** – which will delight both young and old with cute and cuddly animals. Free to enter enclosure.
- **Stage** – A full programme of entertainment to sit and enjoy on both Saturday and Sunday
- **Treasure Hunt** – find clues around the showgrounds. Map available at the Information Stand.
- **Weaving Fun** in the sheep pavilion

➤ **What is the cost of the rides?**

The rides prices are set by the ride operators

Major Rides \$10 – \$15 with discounts for multiple rides

Children's Rides \$5 – \$7 with discounts for multiple rides
