- What time does the Show open?

The Berwick Show opens to the public at 9am both Saturday and Sunday.

What time do the gates close on Saturday?

All gates will close at 9pm on Saturday.

Is there an ATM machine available?

What time are the fireworks?

Are dogs allowed at the show? \geq

Dogs belonging to exhibitors are allowed into the Showgrounds except in signed restricted areas ie. Cattle section, Food Court, and must always be on a leash.
